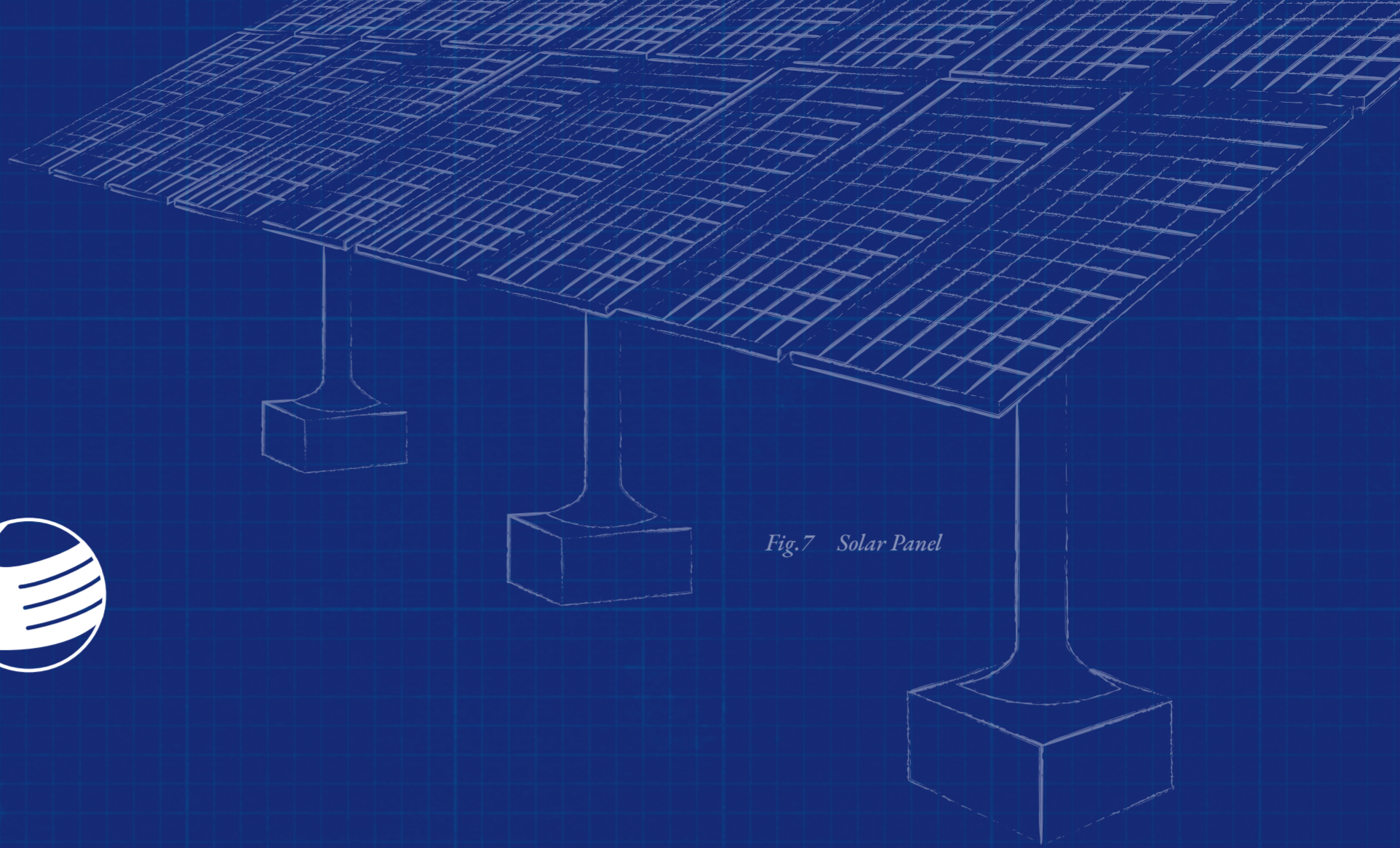


Fig.7 Solar Panel

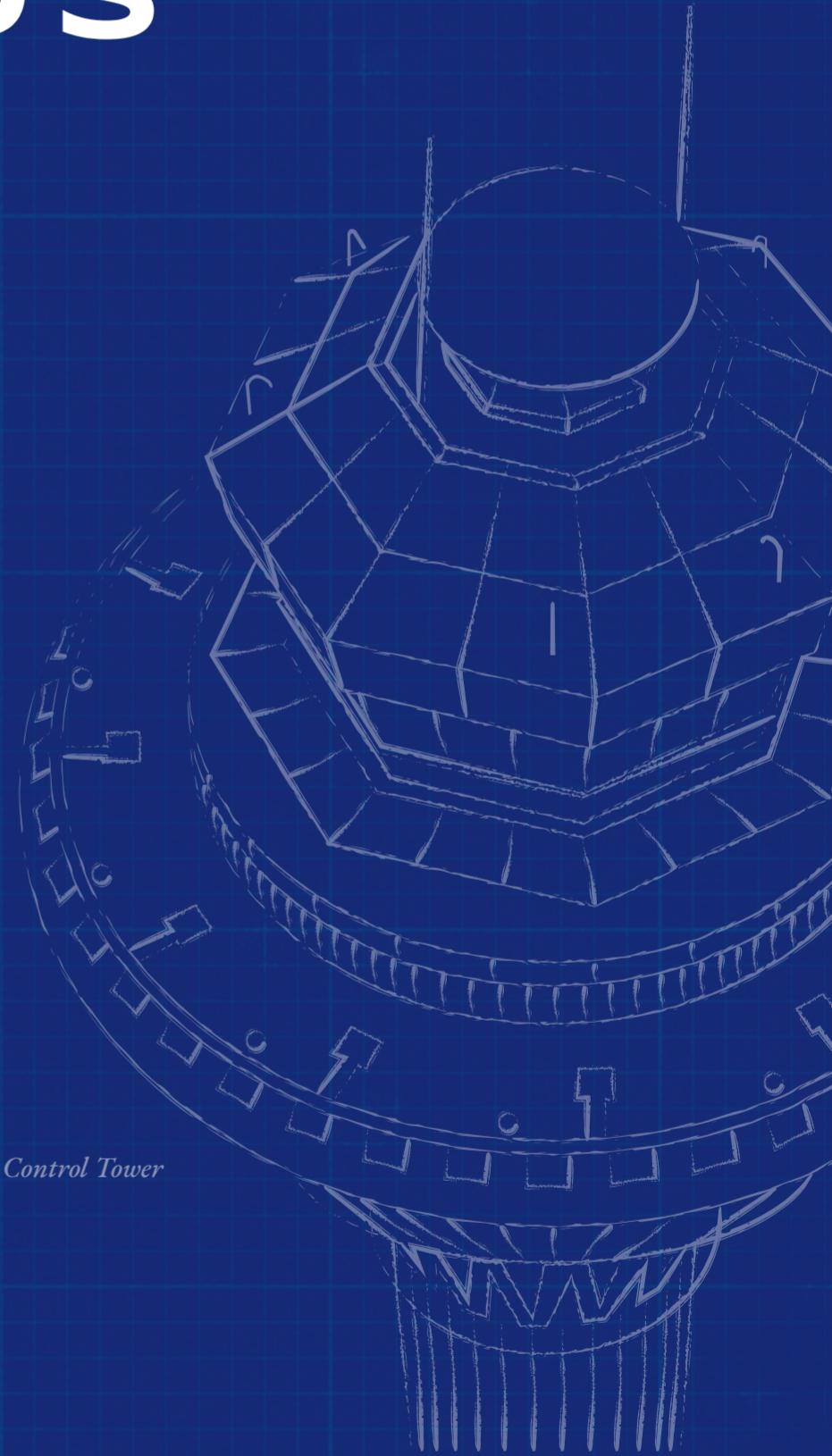


Fig.8 KLIA Air Traffic Control Tower

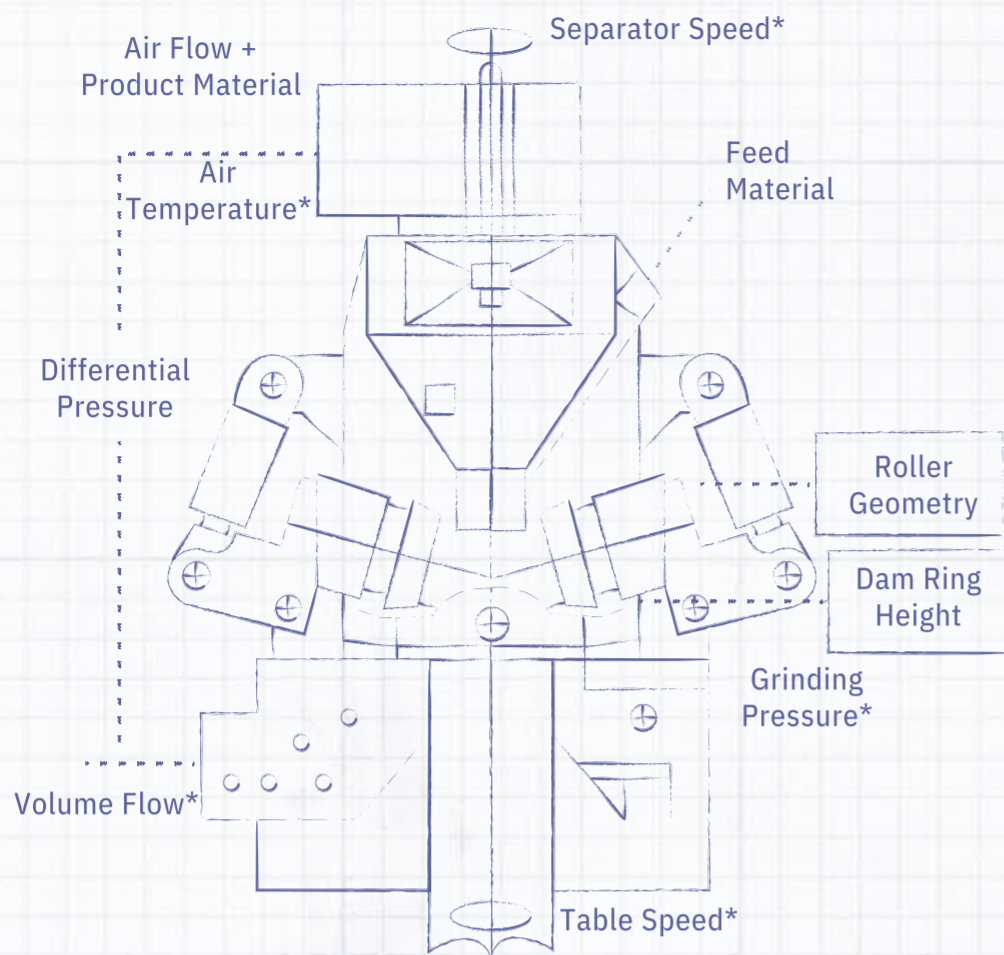


Fig.4 Cement Vertical Roller Mill

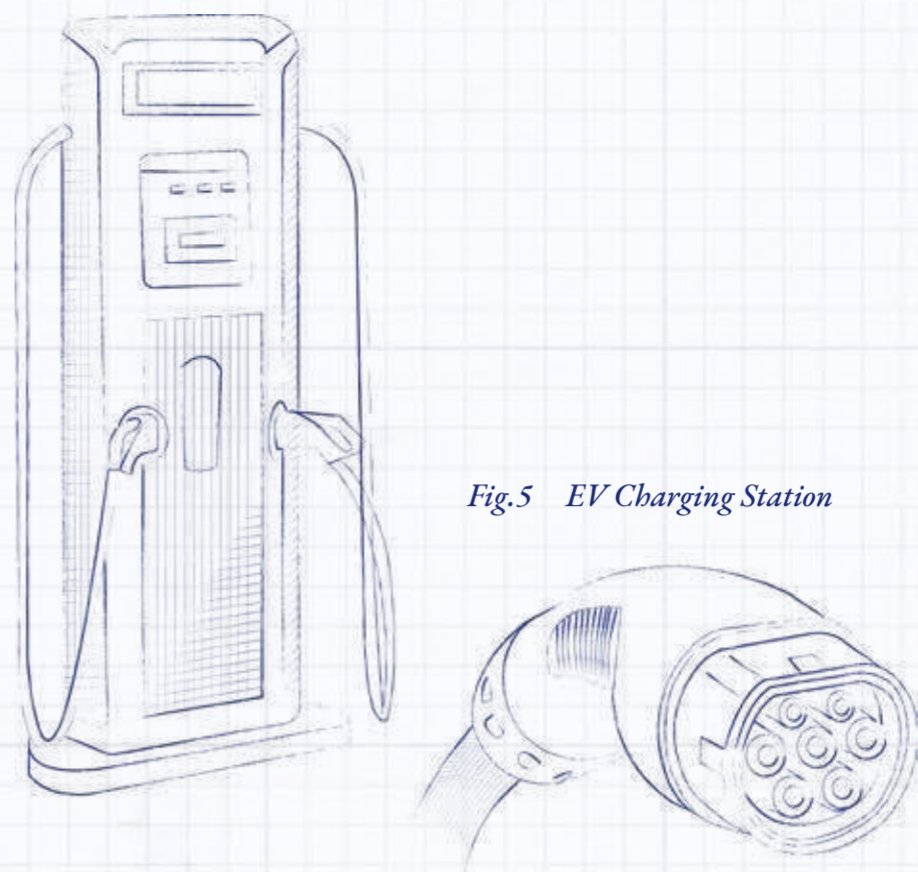


Fig.5 EV Charging Station

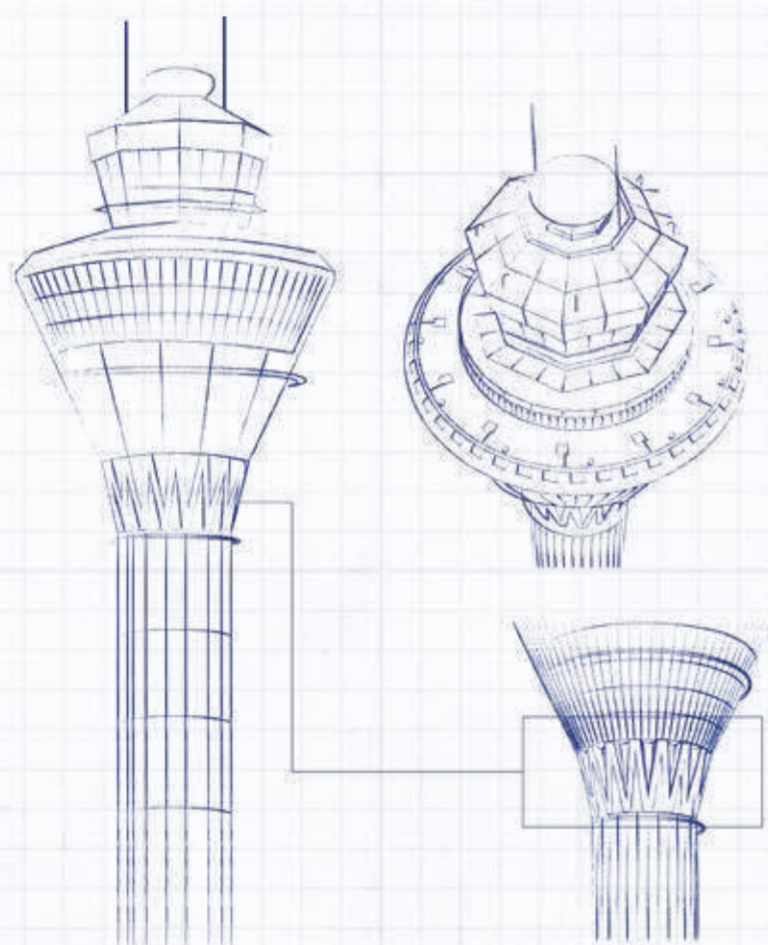


Fig.8 KLIA Air Traffic Control Tower

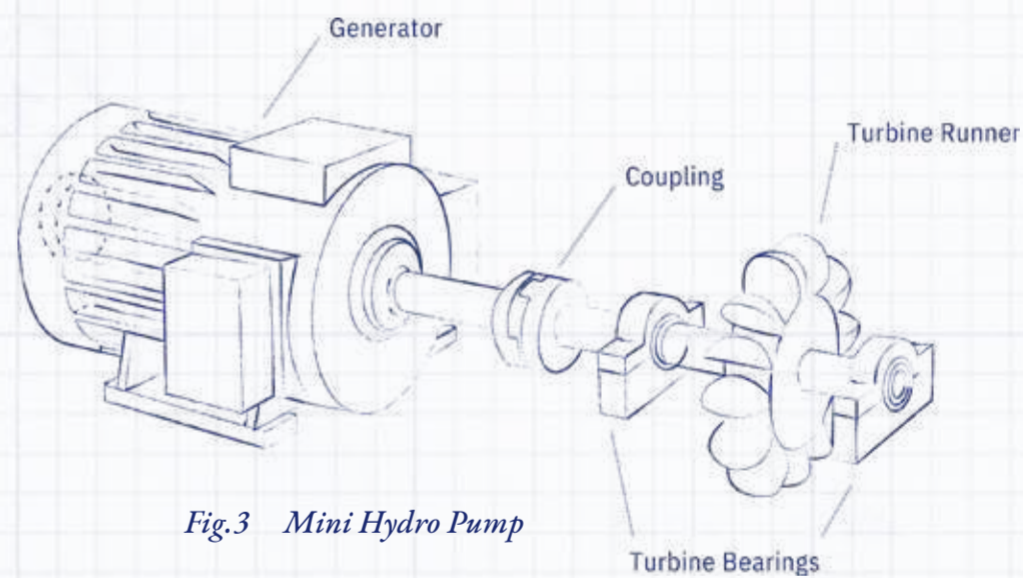


Fig.3 Mini Hydro Pump

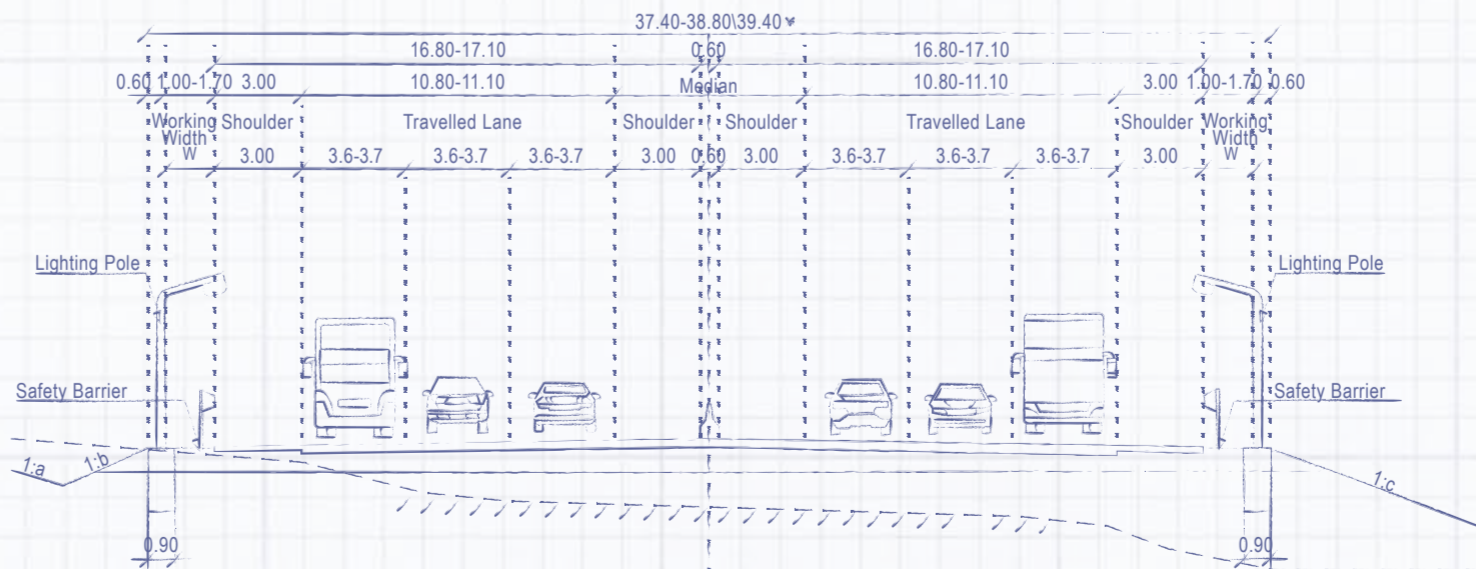


Fig.2 6-lane Expressway Cross Section

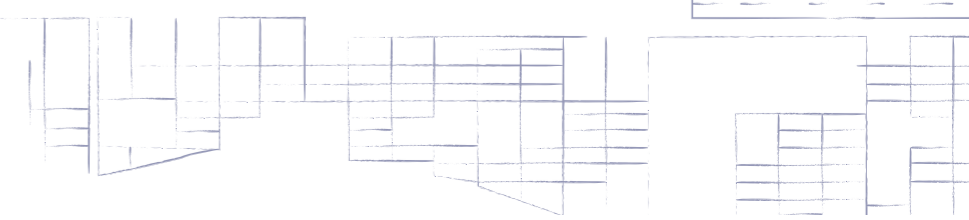
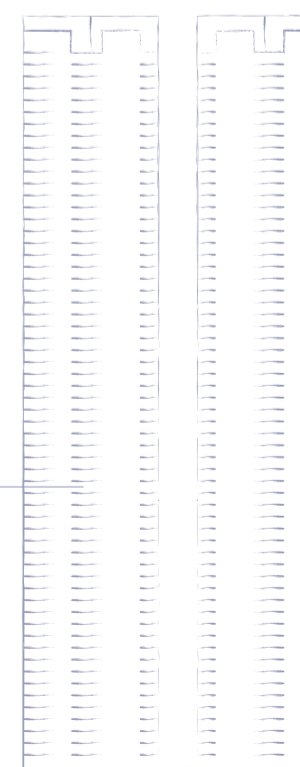
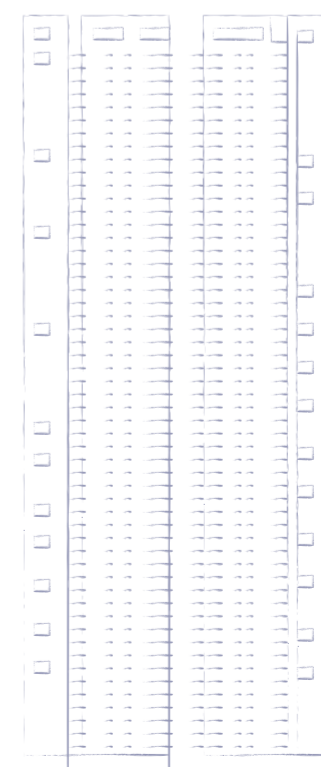
UEM Sunrise is the master developer of Iskandar Puteri, Johor, envisioned to become Southeast Asia's largest fully integrated urban development.

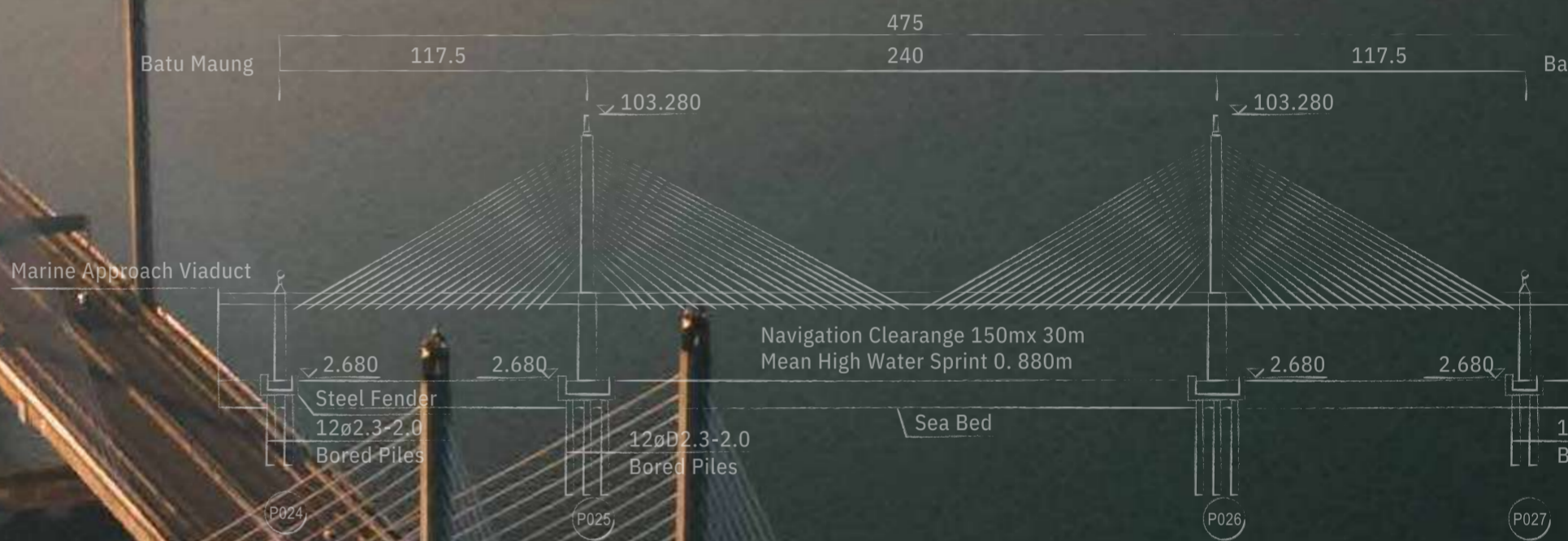


Fig.6 Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah Bridge, Penang



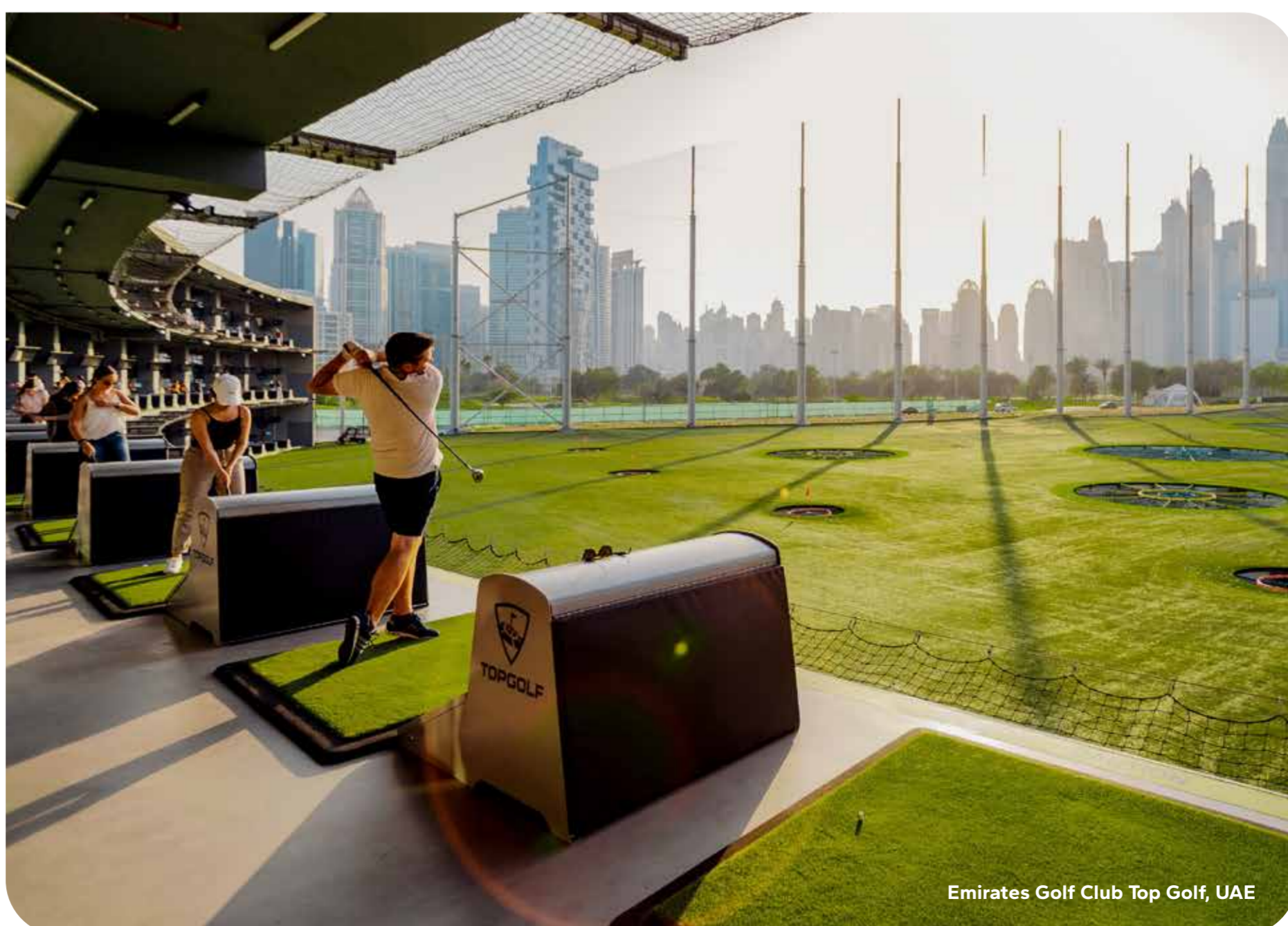

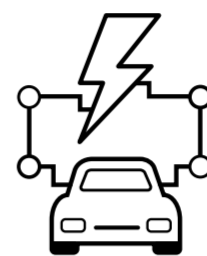

Born from the Malay word, Lestari which means "sustainable", UEM Lestara Berhad (UEM Lestara) is the energy infrastructure arm of UEM Group.

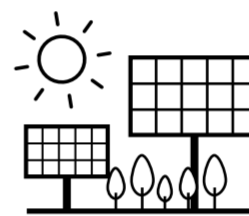

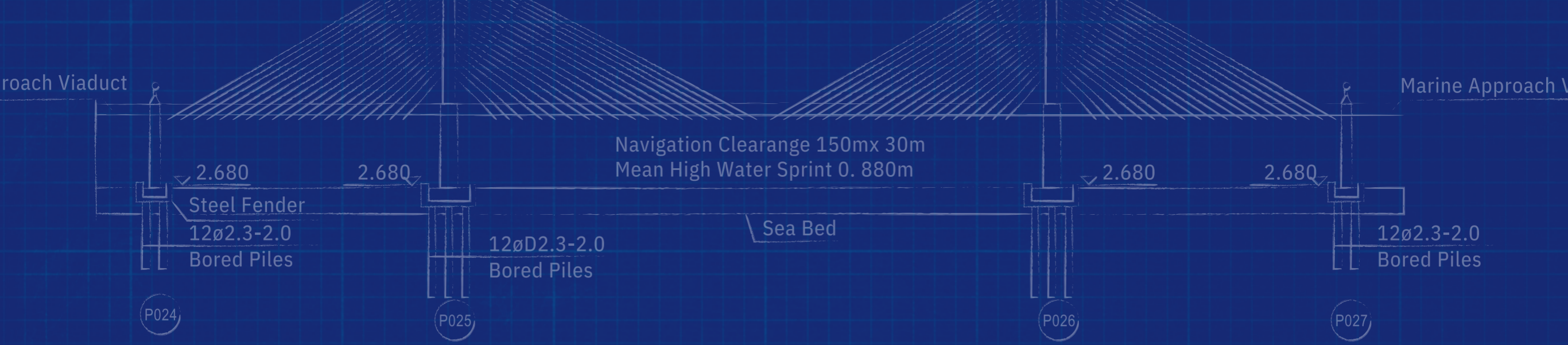


Fig.6 Sultan Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah Bridge, Penang

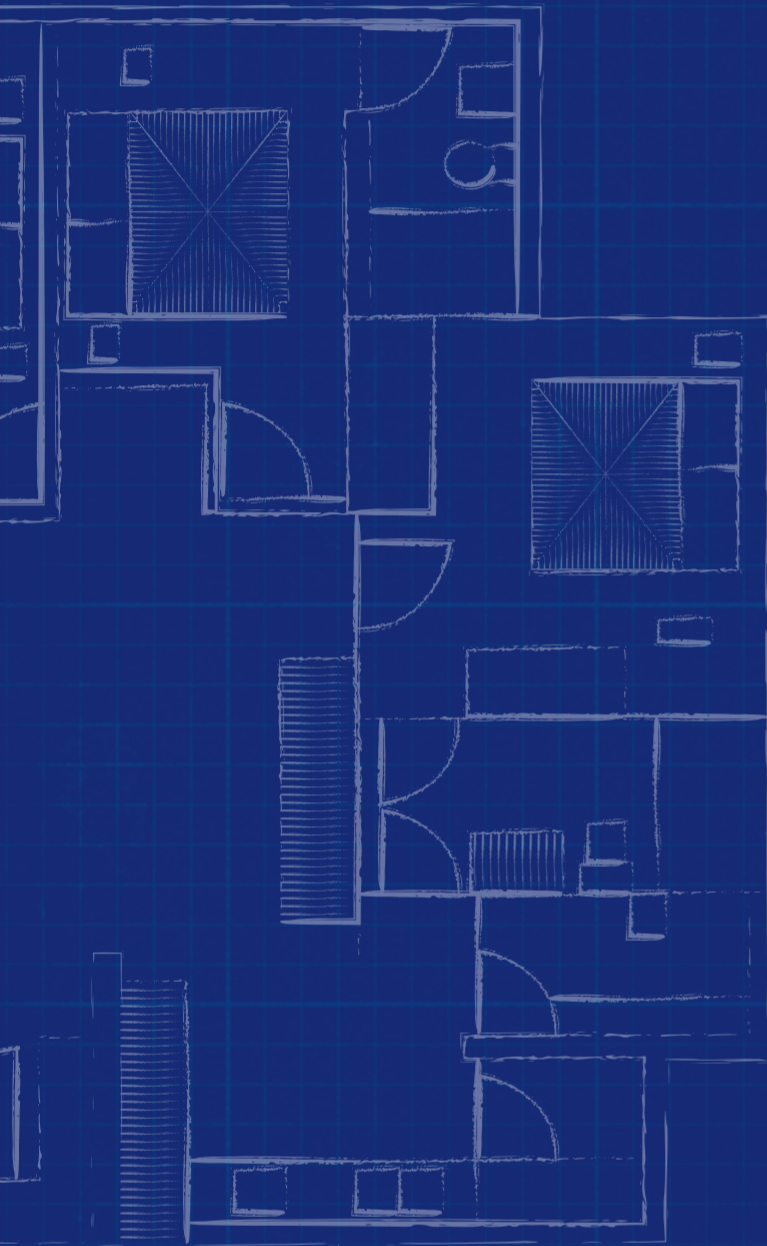


Fig.9 The MINH, Mont Kiara, Luxury Residences
